Project Description:

The Libby Road (CUY-17-20.44) resurfacing project begins at SR-8 (Northfield Road) and goes eastward to Bartlett Road, turns left (north) on Bartlett Road and terminates at SR-43 (Aurora Road). The project will suspend and resume work on Libby Road at the stream crossing and will include both full and partial depth pavement repair. Additionally, curb ramps will be updated to current ADA standards at 100% Bedford Heights cost, and therefore funding is 80 % federal and 20% local. All work will be done within the right-of-way. Based on a consideration and ecological review, the project does not have the potential to impact ecological resources regulated under the under Sections 404 or 401 of the Clean Water Act, Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act, or the Fish and Wildlife Coordination Act, and should not result in any activities that violate ORC Chapters 1518 and 1531, or Section 1533.324. This project is considered Ecologically Exempt under the Ecological MOA (Agreement 19394).

A Cultural Resources Records Check was performed by district environmental staff using the SHPO GIS online database. No Cultural Resources listed on or determined eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places were identified within and/or immediately adjacent to the proposed project area. The undertaking is a type which has minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties. No further coordination is required in accordance with the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement. The Record Check can be found in the Project File Under Cultural Resources/Project Information.

Based upon a decision by the district, no further RMR is necessary for this project. See Project File/ESA/Coordination/District Decision No Further RMR.

The City of Bedford Heights posted a press release to the website https://www.bedfordheights.gov/departments/city_engineer.php providing the public information on the proposed Libby Road (CUY-17-20.44) resurfacing project.
