Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes raised pavement marker maintenance and replacement along various routes throughout ODOT District 4.

On all highways/roadways with four or more lanes, a minimum of one 11-foot lane in each direction shall be maintained on the existing pavement during project construction. On roadways with three or less lanes, a minimum of one 10-foot lane in each direction shall be maintained on the existing pavement during project construction and shoulders shall not be used to maintain traffic. No substantial traffic disruptions are anticipated with the project.

Based on the project scope of work, its Path 1 Preliminary Development Process (PDP) Classification and the proposed maintenance of traffic measures, emergency/public services contact activities were not conducted for the project.

The project has no Federal funding (100% State funded project), does not involve a Federal action and will be constructed within the existing highway/roadway rights-of-way.

Existing utilities within the project study areas will not be impacted/relocated to construct the project.

Portions of the project are within the historic boundaries of five (5) historic districts (Gustavus Center, Mesopotamia, South Main Street, Forest Glen Estates and Newport Allotment) listed in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). No features of the historic districts will be impacted by the project. Based on the nature of the proposed activities, the ODOT Office of Environmental Services (ODOT-OES) is not required to notify the Ohio State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). The project is exempt from consultation with the SHPO under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 149.53 and under stipulations found in the revised State Funded Project Agreement (Agreement No. 17075) between the SHPO and ODOT dated August 22, 2012. The project is an exempted project type and is limited to the installation or maintenance of raised pavement markers as referenced in Appendix A under Item 6. The ODOT-OES Section 106 cultural resource coordination IOC, dated February 9, 2018, for the project can be found in the Project File/Cultural Resources/Coordination subsection as State Funded Project Coordination - OES.pdf.

The project will not impact any environmentally sensitive resources within the project study areas.
