Project Description:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is proposing a project to remediate a petroleum fuel release at the site of the District 2 Headquarters in Bowling Green, OH. To remediate the petroleum hydrocarbons found in ground water near the release site, oxidizing chemicals will be injected into the ground using a system of wells within the spill site. There will be no new right of way needed for this project and there will be no utility impacts. This project will not require any US Army Corps of Engineers waterway permits and it is not located within a special flood hazard area. There will be no ecological impacts as stated in the "Ecological Review Form" in the project file. This project is covered under Appendix A of the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement for State Funded Projects (Agreement No. 17075), which are undertakings with minimal potential to cause effects to historic properties. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2018 and last approximately 60 days. During construction, there will be no impact to the travelling public.

This document was approved based on a document detailing the scope and process of the work required to perform this remediation.
