Project Description:

The village of Boston Heights and ODOT District 4, in cooperation with Summit Metro Parks, propose an erosion/slide repair along 150 feet of the Summit Metro Parks Bike & Hike Trail just east of the Akron Cleveland Road underpass in Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio.

To safely conduct the erosion/slide repair, approximately 1,200 feet of the trail is expected to be closed to trail traffic for up to four (4) weeks during the estimated six (6) weeks of project construction. Trail users will be detoured during construction that is expected to begin in September 2018. Section 4(f) coordination resulted in a Temporary No Use determination for this project. See project file for Section 4(f) coordination documents.

Based on the project scope of work, it's Path 1 Preliminary Development Process (PDP) Classification and the proposed trail maintenance of traffic measures, emergency/public services contact activities were not conducted for the project. Substantial trail traffic disruptions are not anticipated with the project.

The project will be constructed within the existing right-of-way. Existing utilities within the project study area will not be impacted/relocated to construct the project.

Based on the proposed scope of work, the project has minimal potential to cause effects on historic properties. The project will not impact any environmentally sensitive resources within the project study area.

The environmental document and associated studies, as applicable, were approved using the final plans that are located in the project file.

1) The following items will be added to the plans and adhered to during construction: 1) Access to the Bike & Hike Trail will be maintained at all times throughout project construction via a temporary trail detour; 2) Temporary construction fencing will be installed along proposed construction limits prior to the start of construction activities to protect the Bike & Hike Trail and the public; 3) Appropriate signage will be installed to alert users of construction activities and temporary access restrictions and/or closures; 4) Except as necessary to facilitate construction activities, the staging and/or storage of construction equipment will not take place outside proposed construction limits that are within the defined boundaries of the Bike & Hike Trail; and 5) The contractor will closely coordinate the construction schedule with ODOT District 4, the Village of Boston Heights and Summit Metro Parks.
